What does this prayer reveal to us about Jesus' heart? What is the one thing that he wants most for his followers? How do you understand the word "unity"? How does the church struggle with maintaining unity? What would it take for this prayer to come to fruition?

**Day 2**

**Romans 14**

The church in Rome was experiencing division, mainly around religious beliefs and ethnic issues. According to this passage what are some of the underlying issues driving these conflicts? What does this passage have to say about our shared life together? Who is someone that you have a tendency to pass judgment on? How does this passage challenge you?

**Day 3**

**Romans 15**

What does verse 1 mean to you? What is the link in verse 5 between "endurance," "encouragement" and "having the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had"? How does this passage encourage you?

**Day 4**

**1 Thessalonians 3**

What does this chapter have to say about our shared life together? How does this example of faith encourage others? Who do you have in your life that lifts you up like this? Let them know today how much that means to you. Who are you serving in this way?

**Day 5**

**1 Thessalonians 4**

The author is encouraged by the church's love for one another, but what does verse 10 mean when it says to love one another more and more? How do we practically do that? What does that imply about our shared life together? What does this imply about serving?

**Day 6**

**Corinthians 12**

What does this chapter say about the benefits of our shared life together? How do unity and diversity go hand in hand in the life of the church? How are you using your gifts and abilities to help the church carry out its function as the body of Christ? Where do you serve?

**Day 7**

**Ephesians 3:14-4:16**

According to verses 18 and 19 is it possible to experience the full height, width and depth of God apart from our shared life together? Why or why not? How have you experienced the vastness of God's love through community? By serving others? What action step do you need to make in becoming a disciple?
