## Life Steps | May 30-31, 2015

### Day 1

**John 3:1-21**

Nicodemus was a member of the in-crowd. Why did he come to Jesus at night? What does this say about the state of his soul? Is he content, or is he restless? Explain. In your own words what does it mean to be born again? In what ways do you relate to Nicodemus?

### Day 2

**Judges 6**

Why do you think Gideon had a hard time believing God's call on his life? How do you relate to Gideon? What can you learn from Gideon's story?

### Day 3

**Ephesians 1:1-23**

What does this passage have to say about the journey Jesus invites us on? How do we tend to settle for less than this?

### Day 4

**1 Corinthians 4:1-13**

This can be a challenging passage to read in regards to what it means to be a follower of Jesus. How is it contrary to what some people believe it means to follow Jesus? Where is the joy in all of it?

### Day 5

**Matthew 19:16-30**

What drove this man to Jesus? Why was the man unable to let go of his wealth? In encouraging the man to give it all up and come follow him, what was Jesus doing for him? What are some of the things in your own life that Jesus is calling you away from? What is keeping you from letting them go?

### Day 6

**Hebrews 10:19-39**

Every great adventure is going to involve resistance. The author is writing to a group of Christians who are experiencing persecution and who are tempted to give up and "shrink back." How does he encourage them to move forward? How does this passage challenge you? How does this passage encourage you?

### Day 7

**John 15:1-17**

Read John 15:1-17 in light of the adventure Jesus invites us into. What does it have to say about our invitation? What is the significance of verse 16? What does it mean to remain in Jesus? What does that look like for you?
