**Mark 3:13-15**

Verse 13 says Jesus called to those he “wanted,” and verse 14 says, “He appointed the twelve that they might be with him.” What does this tell us about the meaning of discipleship? Do you feel like you are “wanted” by Jesus? Explain. In your own words, what does it mean to be with Jesus?

**Day 2**

**John 10:1-21**

What does Jesus mean when he refers to himself as the “gate”? Why would these words divide the Jews who heard them? Why would some think that Jesus was possessed? What about this passage encourages you?

**Day 3**

**Exodus 33**

After reading this chapter, what are some of the characteristics you admire about Moses? What would you say is his greatest desire? What gives him the confidence to ask God to show his “glory”? What about Moses’ example challenges you?

**Day 4**

**2 Samuel 6**

Why do you think David danced in front of the people and before the Lord in his underwear? Why do you think his wife, Michal “despised him in her heart”? What does this passage have to say to us about true worship and how we are to celebrate God’s presence in our lives?

**Day 5**

**Acts 3**

What does this chapter have to say about bearing witness for Jesus? Peter said they didn’t have any gold or silver, but what did they have? What was the result of their courage and faithfulness? How does their example challenge you?

**Day 6**

**Ephesians 6:10-20**

What does this passage say about confronting evil? What does Paul mean when he says, “Our struggle is not against flesh and blood”? What is our struggle against? How do we win that fight? Describe in your own words what it means to put on the full armor of God.

**Day 7**

**Luke 11:14-28**

What is Jesus talking about in the parable about the strong man? Who or to what is Jesus referring? What does Jesus mean when he says, “Whoever is not with me is against me”? If being with Jesus means we will bear witness and confront evil, how do both of these manifest themselves in your own life? How could they become more a part of your life?
