



TRUE CONTENTMENT

Tuesday, March 14 | Timothy 6:6-10

As we journey in this life there is tremendous value in drawing near to sound instruction. Paul's primary concern in this text centers around the distractions that happen when we redirect our focus from teachings of the Gospel to the things of this world. When we move from "Christ-sufficiency" to "self-sufficiency" we lose focus, making it easier to buy into lies of our materialistic society. God's intent for us is to live a life in relationship with him.

Today, let's ask ourselves if through our thoughts and habits, we are setting patterns in motion that move us closer to true contentment found in Christ, or are we stuck in the trap of seeking contentment in material things?

PRAYER: Father, I desire wholeness in this life that only you can give. I may have a desire for the riches of this world, but I know that is not your desire. So today I am asking you to help me understand what my distractions are, and what is designed by you, as I long for contentment that can only be found in you.

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
