Monday I Timothy 1:1-6/Hebrews 11:1-39/James 2:14-26 How would you describe your faith? High impact or low impact? Sincere or insincere? Alive or dead? Other? Explain. Refer to your message notes, what is your next step so that you are fanning your Spiritual Gifts into flame?

Tuesday I Peter 4:8-11/Matthew 25:14-30

Spiritual Gifts are like a bag of gold. How would others know you value your Spiritual Gifts? Or, lose the mask, why haven't you discovered and deployed your Spiritual Gifts? Why is it important to fan into flame your Spiritual Giftedness. Action Step?

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Wednesday Romans 12:1-21

According to vs. 1-2, what is the motivation for living out verses 3-21? Explain why you do or do not find this motivation compelling. If you could choose any of these Spiritual Gifts (Vs. 6-8) which would you choose? Why? Which of the list of commands (vs. 9-21) are the most relevant to you right now? Why?

Thursday I Corinthians 12:1-11

Why do you think Paul wrote to the Corinthian Church about Spiritual Gifts? What are spiritual gifts? Where do they come from and why is that important to know? What is the purpose of Spiritual Gifts and why is that important to know?

Friday I Corinthians 12:12-31

What are the implications that we are a vital part of a living organism? What problems does it appear Paul was addressing in the Corinthian church? (Vs. 15-26) Why would these issues be so divisive? How does this text challenge and encourage you?

Saturday Ephesians 4:11-16

Reflect upon your own desires to grow towards becoming Christ Centered. Draw a graph of how much you have been growing since you became a Christian. What factors led you to grow more or less? Journal all of the possible ways your serving role is helping Pathway to grow into more of a healthy Church body.

Sunday Romans 8:1-17

According to this passage, what are the differences between someone who lives according to their sinful nature and someone who lives according to the Spirit? How do verses 14-17 encourage you? How would you describe your picture of who God is?
