

2 TIMOTHY: Lose The Mask

Life Steps | June 2 & 3, 2018

Monday

Matthew 23:13-32

Define hypocrisy in your own words. Why do you think Jesus came down so hard on the Pharisees? (Hint found in Matthew 23:1-4) What might have been the motive for the Pharisee's hypocrisy? (Vs. 27) How would you respond to someone who refuses to attend worship because "the church is full of hypocrites?"

Tuesday

Galatians 2:11-21

What was Peter's hypocrisy? Which mask do you believe Peter was wearing? Why? How would you explain "justified by faith in Christ" (vs. 16) to someone who is not a believer? How does your explanation impact what it means to "live for God?" (Vs. 19)

Wednesday

I Samuel 16:1-7

"People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." What will people see when they see your outward appearance today? What will the Lord see when he looks at your heart today?

Thursday

I Peter 1:13-2:3

What does the command "be holy" mean to you? (Vs. 15) Review your message notes. Which mask or masks of hypocrisy do you need to lose? (Vs 1) Why? How have you tasted that the Lord is good?

Friday

Psalms 147:1-3 & I Peter 2:24

What wounds are your masks covering up? Where or among what group of people do you most wear your masks? Why? What action step will you take to lose the masks?

Saturday

2 Timothy 1:1-5

Describe the impact a mentors has had upon your life. Why did you allow them to mentor you? Or, who will you invite into your life to serve as a mentor? Why them? Where do you most need them to speak into your life? How would you describe your faith? (Vs 5)

Sunday

Exodus 14:10-14, 29-31

Moses mentorship had a huge impact upon a whole nation. Who do you know that needs to be reminded that "the Lord will fight for you"? What action steps will you take to begin a mentoring relationship? If no one comes to mind, pray that God will bring a Timothy into your life.
