Monday

2 Timothy 3:2-4

Paul lists for Timothy the different forms of destructive behavior that he needs to watch out for. As you read through the list, think about which ones you struggle with. As a part of your morning journaling, reflect on why you think this is a struggle for you.

Tuesday

Matthew 6:19-24

Jesus tells us that we can have only one master. He tells us, just as Paul reminds us, that we cannot love money and love God; we have to pick one. Greed can manifest in ways beyond money. People can be greedy with things like time, attention, and even service. What area of your life do you see greed manifesting?

Wednesday

Matthew 7:15-20

Jesus warns us about people who appear to be Godly but are not. He tells us to pay attention to the fruit of the tree. Think about the people in your circle, the people that you allow to have influence over you. What Godly qualities do they possess?

Thursday

Luke 22:39-44

As Jesus prepared to journey to the cross he was anxious about the pain that was coming. Yet, in spite of his anxiety, he continued to surrender to the will of God. Think about a time when your journey with Christ involved you surrendering to things that you did not want to do. What was the result of your surrender?

Friday

2 Timothy 3:12

Paul tells Timothy that his journey to live a Godly life will lead to persecution. While we live in a different context, our journey does involve sacrifice. Think back to when you first began your journey. What were some of the sacrifices that you had to make then to begin this journey?

Saturday

Matthew 6:1-4

Jesus reminds us not to announce our good deeds to the world, or to boast about how we serve. Begin your day today by reflecting on the selfless service of Jesus. Keep this with you today and look for people that you can serve today without them knowing it was you that served them.

Sunday

Psalms 1

This psalm mirrors Paul's conversation with Timothy about Godliness. It reminds us that the Godly person is the one who meditates on the word of God day and night. As you prepare for worship today, remember to delight in the word of God beyond your morning reading time. Pick a favorite verse and keep it with you, meditate on it throughout the day.
