Monday

I Timothy 6:3-10

How would you describe the level of importance of money in your life? How has money been a source of “grief” or joy in your family? According to your current financial habits, what percentage do you give to God, save, and spend monthly? Pray, asking God for wisdom in your financial matters.

Tuesday

Proverbs 6:5 | Proverbs 21:20

Where is your spending of money out of control? For those who are not saving, what are the excuses that are preventing you from saving? Pray, asking God for self-discipline in your spending habits.

Wednesday

Matthew 7:7 | Proverbs 22:7

Name a time God met a financial need through prayer? What did the situation teach you about the power of prayer? How would your life be different without the burden of debt? Pray, thanking God for help and guidance in getting out of debt. Record any action steps.

Thursday

Genesis 1:27 | Malachi 3:10 | 2 Corinthians 9:7

Even though God is a giver and God created us in his own image, why is it difficult for us to give? Why do you think God asks us to test him in tithing? Do you give cheerfully or out of guilt? What is the connection between our hearts and our giving? Pray as you are led.

Friday

Luke 19:1-10

Review your message notes. Zacchaeus had a double conversion when he encountered Jesus, spiritual and financial. In what areas of your life do you still need God to do some transforming work? Pray, asking God to reveal the action steps you need to take.

Saturday

Colossians 1:17

Review your message notes from our My Crazy Family message series. What are your key learnings and action steps? Pray for Jesus to remain at the center of your family.

Sunday

Psalms 150

Write out this Psalm in your own words, praising God for how his “surpassing greatness” has showed up in you personally and your family as a whole.
