

## **Easter:** The Story of God and Us

### **Monday**

**I John 4:7-21**

What does “God is love” mean to you? How might your life be different if you lived daily as a loved child of God? Who in your life do you sense God asking you to love?

### **Tuesday**

**Genesis 1-2:3**

Everyone and everything came into existence because of God’s love. How does that statement impact your understanding of the Creation story?

### **Wednesday**

**Genesis 3 | I John 5:19**

Evil is alive and on the loose in the world. Where do you see evil working in the world that most disturbs you? How is evil creating havoc in you and/or your family? Pray as you are led.

### **Thursday**

**I John 1-2:2**

What does “God is light” mean to you? How would you describe your relationship with Jesus?

### **Friday**

**Luke 24:1-12**

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ was the pivot point in all of history. What was the initial response of the women and the disciples to this news? How has Jesus been a pivot point in your life?

### **Saturday**

**Romans 10:1-13**

Our loving God gave us free will. We are free to choose or reject him. Why do you think God gave us free will? What are some of your forthcoming critical choices that you would like to ask God for wisdom?

### **Sunday**

**II Corinthians 5:17**

Memorize this verse. God is in the restoration business. Where do you most need God to do a restoring work in your life? Why? Spend some time articulating your need to God. Consider writing it out in the form of a prayer in your journal.
