

# Colossians: ReThink | The Supremacy of Jesus

## Monday

### Colossians 1:15-23

What do you think Paul's message is to the Colossians in this section of his letter? According to Paul, what makes Jesus unique? See your message notes as needed.

## Tuesday

### John 1:1-18

What is the message that John is communicating about Jesus? How does the fact that God left heaven to move in your neighborhood, impact your understanding of God's love for you?

## Wednesday

### Isaiah 9:2-7

Many Christians and much of our world is confused about who Jesus really is. Which metaphor for Jesus in this passage most resonates for you and why? Reflect upon who you know that might be turned off or disinterested in the Church. What characteristics of Jesus will you model so they might be open to reconnecting with Jesus and His Church?

## Thursday

### Philippians 2:1-11

What would it look like for you to have the same "mindset" or "attitude" of Jesus? What would it look like for you to imitate Jesus when it comes to "downward mobility?"

## Friday

### Hebrews 4:14-5:10

Prophets speak to the people on behalf of God. Priests speak to God on behalf of the People. According to this passage, what qualifies Jesus to serve as our high priest? In what sense did Jesus learn "obedience from what he suffered?" What is your takeaway from this passage?

## Saturday

### Revelation 1:9-20

How would you describe the reaction of John when he saw the Resurrected Jesus? What does Jesus reveal about himself? What comfort do you draw from this passage?

## Sunday

### Colossians 1:1-23

What are your primary learnings thus far from our study of Chapter 1? How would you answer anyone who asked you, "Who is Jesus?" How is your life bearing testimony to the supremacy of Jesus?
