Monday

Colossians 1:24-2:5

How does Paul describe his purpose in life and calling? How can you apply this section of Paul's letter to the Colossians to your own life?

Tuesday

Matthew 23:1-12

Jesus came down hard on the Pharisees for certain aspirational behaviors. What are those behaviors and how have you seen them manifested in Christians in our modern era? How have you seen any of them in yourself? Pray for transformation as needed.

Wednesday

Romans 1:1 | Philippians 1:1 | Colossians 1:25 | Titus 1:1

Paul consistently introduced himself as a servant of God. Considering the Roman Culture, why do you think Paul so emphasized his a servanthood identity? Reflection, what do you think is the difference between a volunteer and a servant?

Thursday

1 Corinthians 3:1-23

Paul was a Roman citizen and very well versed in the Via Romana, the way of the Romans (Vs 1). Comparatively speaking, how would you describe the Via Americana? Refer to your message notes as needed. What single verse in this passage most resonates with you and why?

Friday

1 Peter 4:12-19 | Colossians 1:24

Have you ever had to endure a "fiery ordeal" because of your faith in Jesus? If so explain. What did you learn? If not, reflect upon the experience of someone you know who has and journal your lessons learned. How can we experience rejoicing when suffering? (James 1:2-4)

Saturday

Mark 8:34-9:1

How might we try to "save our life?" What things might we do if we "lose our life" for his sake? List all of the attributes you would use to describe a disciple. Where are you weak? Where are you growing? Where are you strong?

Sunday

Colossians 1:24-2:5

Reflection, do you spend more of your time ascending, pursuing the glory of this world or descending, pursuing the glory of Christ? Explain. In this passage, how does Paul describe the glorious life?
