Monday

Acts 2

Consider that when the church was formed many people from many places gathered, but they could all understand each other as the Holy Spirit fell upon them. Think back to how past misunderstandings have challenged relationships for you. Is there one now that requires attention and clarification? Pray that God might help you convey love to another in spite of any misunderstandings.

Tuesday

1 Corinthians 13:4-8

Reflect on Paul's definition of love today. As you consider how you interact with others, does this description align with how you convey love to them? If there is one that you need to work on more than another, which would it be?

Wednesday

John 15:1-17

As a follower of Jesus, you might think of yourself as a branch of Him. If He is the vine and we are the branches, what fruit are we producing? What would it look like for you to "produce fruit" that is generated from your relationship with Jesus?

Thursday

Philippians 2:3-4

What would it look like if we viewed others as those to be served instead of looking how others might serve us? In your connecting with people in the days to come, approach them as people in need of Christ's love which you have to share. How many different ways might you share it?

Friday

Romans 15:1-7

What does it mean to live in harmony with other Christians who might believe differently from you? How do you transcend the culture's pressure to villainize others who are different and love all people, viewing them as created children of God?

Saturday

Proverbs 27:17

Memorize this verse today. Reflect on the people who will speak truthfully in love to you and consider their counsel for a current struggle. Also consider who might receive your counsel as coming from a safe and loving person in their life.

Sunday

Ecclesiastes 4:12

Another one to memorize today. Get with your small group and lay out a calendar for the fall. Consider how you will be impactful in a way you haven't before.
