

Oh What Fun! : Peacemakers

Monday

Isaiah 2:1-5

What does this passage teach us about the nature of God? Write out verse 4 in your own words, giving consideration to the current state of the world and the language of our culture.

Tuesday

Isaiah 7:1-17

King Ahaz learns Jerusalem is about to be attacked. The prophet Isaiah challenges him to stand firm in his faith and speaks of a sign to come in verse 14. Reflect upon a time you felt under attack and the promise of Immanuel, God with us, gave you comfort. What did you learn from the experience?

Wednesday

Isaiah 8:18-9:7

What do we learn about Jesus in verses 6-7? Which of your learnings encourage you the most? What does it mean "the greatness of the government will be on his shoulders" and "His peace will not end, increase or decrease" and He will both "establish and uphold" his kingdom?

Thursday

Isaiah 11:1-16

What do we learn about Jesus from this chapter? What do we learn about the impact Jesus will have upon the world? How does this passage encourage you? Explain.

Friday

John 14:15-27

What is the difference between the peace offered by the world and offered by Jesus? How can we tell if we are walking in the peace of God? Pray for people you know who need God's peace.

Saturday

Colossians 3:15

Describe what it would look like for peace to rule in your heart? What does "you were called to peace" mean to you?

Sunday

I Peter 3:8-11

Review your conflict transformation message notes. Name anyone with whom you have had a recent disruption. Are you moving away or towards them? What is the state of your heart towards them? What is your next step of conflict transformation?
