Monday

Acts 2:42-47

The early church was a vibrant community where the Lord added daily "those who were being saved." Besides the moving of the Holy Spirit, why do you think so many people were attracted to the first church? What are the unique Pathway dynamics that have led to people coming to know Jesus?

Tuesday

Acts 4:32-27

Describe the mindset and attitude of believers in the early church. What inspires you in this passage?

Wednesday

Acts 5:1-10

What do you think motivated Ananias and Sapphira to withhold some of the proceeds of their land sale? What does the "fear of God" mean to you?

Thursday

John 14:1-6

What does this passage say about God's character? Describe the strengths and weaknesses of your own character. Where are you most vulnerable to stretching or distorting the truth?

Friday

Proverbs 1:1-7

How is wisdom and the attributes of character different for those who "fear the Lord?" How does prudence and discretion to the young look like in our church family, in your biological family?

Saturday

Proverbs 1:8 – 2:5

What parts of your character are not traits of the character of God? Review your message notes. What are your next steps for getting stronger in your truth telling character?

Sunday

I John 1:5-2:2

God wants us to tell the truth. Pray, telling God the truth about your character issues and ask for forgiveness. "God, today I commit myself to verbal precision." Pray for your friends who are far from God.
