Monday

Psalm 33

Define hope. What are the actions of God in Psalm 33 that encourage us to “wait in hope for the Lord?” (Vs. 20) Are you more hopeful or hopeless this Christmas? Explain.

Tuesday

John 1:19-42

What do you think the two disciples really wanted from Jesus? What do you want from Christmas 2019? What do you want for your family?

Wednesday

John 3:1-21

According to this passage, what were some of the reasons God sent Jesus into the world? What does “born again” mean to you? What are some of the current needs of your family and friends? How are you going to be “radically generous” towards them?

Thursday

John 1:1-18

How does John describe Jesus in these opening verses of his Gospel? Which verse is the most memorable to you? Why? What are some of your favorite family Christmas traditions? How will you help create memory making traditions this Christmas?

Friday

Luke 3:1-20

John the Baptist’s primary role in the Christmas story was preparing a way for the Lord. (Vs. 4) How are you preparing to make a way for Jesus into your family this Christmas? Prayerfully commit to God your preparation plan.

Saturday

Psalm 31

What are the characteristics of God described by David in Psalm 31 that allows him to finish this Psalm by encouraging readers to be hopeful? (Vs. 24) Refer to your Monday journal entry. Are you less or more hopeful today? Explain

Sunday

Isaiah 40:28-31

Rewrite this passage word for word in your journal. What word, phrase or sentence will you most hold on to today? Why?
