Monday

Luke 15:1-2, 11-20

How would you describe your current relationship with God? What do you expect from God? In your mind, what makes you unworthy to be called a child of God? Record in your journal a personal prayer of confession.

Tuesday

Luke 15:1-2, 1-24

How does it make you feel to discover the ridiculous reality that God is pursuing a relationship with you, even when you are behaving badly? Recall a party that was held in your honor. How did you feel? Pray for the people you know that are far from God with whom you are working to build a relationship.

Wednesday

Luke 15:1-2, 11-32

Which character in his parable do you most identify with and why? Write your own definition of grace.

Thursday

Romans 12:1-10

What are your greatest weaknesses? (Vs. 5) How has God's power been made perfect in your weakness? (Vs. 9) What does "For when I am weak, then I am strong" mean to you? (Vs. 10) Who are you inviting to join you in worship this weekend?

Friday

Ephesians 2:1-10

How have you most received the "incomparable riches" of God's grace? Are you a better grace receiver or grace giver? How has this impacted your relationship with God?

Saturday

Ephesians 2:11-22

Describe the people who are hardest for you to love. Describe the people for whom you find it difficult to rejoice with when God does good things for them. How does it make you feel when you read God wants to use you and the people hard for you to love to become a common dwelling place for God? (Vs. 19-22)

Sunday

Psalms 103

How does Psalm 103 better help you understand the ridiculous nature of God's grace?
