## Love Playlist: Love Somebody Like You

### Monday

**1 John 4:7-12**

This week we talked about how God's love precedes everything else in life. As you begin your day, write down three moments in the past year where you have felt the love of God in unexpected ways.

### Tuesday

**Matthew 14:22-33**

Jesus walks on the water in the middle of a storm. He then calls out to Peter and invites Peter to do the same. Peter shockingly steps out of the boat. Who are the people that you trust enough to risk your own safety for? Why do you trust them?

### Wednesday

**Mark 5:1-20**

Jesus encounters the Gerasene demoniac. But Jesus doesn't treat him like a demoniac; he treats him like a child of God. When was there a moment in your life when someone else spoke into your potential rather than your current broken condition? How did this change your life?

### Thursday

**John 21:15-17**

Even after Peter denied Jesus three times at such a critical time, Jesus still doesn't give up on Peter. Jesus continues to speak new life into Peter. Who are the people that you have given up on or written off? Maybe boundaries need to be in place, but how might you continue to pray for them as a way to keep speaking into their life?

### Friday

**Matthew 4:18-22**

Jesus was intimately invested in the success of the disciples. He calls out the ones that nobody else wanted...the not-good-enoughs, and spends the next three years pouring into them, not giving up on them, breathing new life into them. Who are you pouring into today? Whose success are you invested in?

### Saturday

**1 John 4:18**

Keep this verse with you all day. As you enter into circumstances where you are afraid, repeat this verse. Remember, you don't have to trust everyone, but you can still have trust in all things. The perfect love of God casts out your fear today. Live in this freedom today.

### Sunday

**Psalms 1**

Read this psalm as you prepare for worship. Remember that you cannot give to people what you have not taken in. Worship today as you fill up with the love of God, so you can go out into the world and let that love flow through you.
