Monday

I Samuel 8:1-22

What insights did you learn from worship and the message that encouraged you? Why did the Israelites reject God as their King? What insights does this passage give us about our presidential election?

Tuesday

Mark 15:1-15 | John 18:33-36

What parallels do you see between these two passages and Monday's reading from I Samuel? What insight does this election, of who was to die and who was to be set free, give into our current election?

Wednesday

Philippians 2:9-11 | Ephesians 1:18-22

What was God the Father's plan for Jesus that required a cross? What word or phrase from these two passages will you reflect on for the rest of the day? Why?

Thursday

Isaiah 9:6-7 | John 18:36-37 | Philippians 2:5-8

What are some characteristics described of Jesus as president or supreme ruler? How is this different from human rulers? What is your primary take away from these passages?

Friday

I Timothy 2:1-2

Be involved. What is your plan as a follower of Jesus, for fully engaging in the election process? Pray for both Presidential candidates.

Saturday

Romans 13:1-6 | Titus 3:1-2

What are some of our biblical responsibilities towards our government? In light of our faith, what is to be our attitude towards those we disagree with politically? Pray for your local election candidates.

Sunday

Revelation 21:1-3

How does this vision help us keep the 2020 election in perspective and not be anxious?
