



Small Group Lesson 2 | Life Changing Words: Yes

Main Idea: We are designed and created to say yes to God and others.

Main Scripture: 2 Corinthians 1:18-20

Get Connected:

1. Describe a time you spoke a life-changing “Yes” to another person.
2. When have you said “Yes” to God?

In the Word:

Read 2 Corinthians 1:18-20

1. What is Paul’s primary point in this passage?
2. How are all of God’s promises a “Yes” in Jesus Christ?

**Read Genesis 12:2-3/Joshua 1:9/Psalm 32:8/Matthew 11:28-29/John 8:51/
Romans 8:28/Colossians 3:3-4/1 John 1:9**

1. Divide the above verses among the group and have each person, in turn, read their verse out loud.
2. Which of these promises of God are the most relevant to you at this time and why?
3. What happens in us when we believe that God keeps all of His promises?

Application:

1. What does it mean to you to say “Yes” to God?
2. How will you say “Yes” to God between now and Easter?
3. Review the five ways we can make space for others in our lives. Between now and Easter, which of these will you intentionally strive to practice? Why?

Possible Closing Prayer: Father, thank you for giving us all of your promises. Thank you for sending Jesus to be your ultimate “Yes” to us. Guide us through each day. Show us our next step towards you. Help us to say “Yes” to the people in our lives as often as possible. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
