Read 2 Kings 6:24-7:20

- 1. Describe how it might have felt to be in Samaria during the siege and the famine?
- 2. How would Elisha's words (7:1) have sounded in those circumstances?
- 3. What rationale did the lepers use to leave the city? (7:3-4)
- 4. How did the lepers become aware of their Blind Spot? (7:8-9)
- 5. What was the result of the leper's report to the king?
- 6. What do you think the Israelites learn about God through this experience?

Application:

- 1. How were you impacted by the sharing of our new Ukrainian friends?
- 2. When have you faced the decision like the lepers, to serve or not serve by sharing and choosing differently than they did? What was the impact on your heart/mind/soul?
- 3. Do you serve others as a lifestyle or in selective moments depending on how you feel or convenience? Explain.

Pray: Generous God, open our blind eyes to see the riches of your blessings, our possessions, income, health, relationships, spiritual gifts, experiences or the simple gift of living in your grace. Like the lepers, give us the courage and integrity to join you in opening up "the floodgates of heaven" upon those who live in desperate need. In Jesus name, amen.
