Well Connected: Anything is Possible | September 2 & 3, 2023

Monday

John 4:1-42

Reflect: Reflect on Jesus and the Samaritan woman and what you have learned during our “Well Connected” message series. What specific things do you want Jesus to help you grow in your faith and practice?

Tuesday

Matthew 19:16-25

Wednesday

John 7:42 | John 16:24

Reflect: As a follower of Jesus within whose soul flows “rivers of living water,” consider how the John 16 passage can assist in increasing your faith that “with God, anything is possible.”

Prayer: Pray as you are led for your anything is possible prayer. Consider texting a Pathway friend and ask if you could join them in praying for their anything is possible prayer.

Thursday

John 14:12-14

Reflect: What is your response to Jesus’ words in verse 12? How does this passage assist in strengthening your faith?

Prayer: Pray your anything is possible prayer. Consider taking a picture of your anything is possible prayer, then send it to a trusted friend, asking them to pray.

Friday

John 15: 5-8

Reflect: Disciples of Jesus bear fruit. Fruit is, in part, the result of a healthy and meaningful prayer life. How does this passage encourage you? How does this passage inspire you to grow in your prayer life?

Prayer: Pray your anything is possible prayer. Use language from today’s passage as a part of your prayer.

Saturday

Jeremiah 33:1-3

Reflect: What insights would you like for God to reveal to you in regards to your anything is possible prayer?

Prayer: Ask for God to make known the “great and unsearchable things you do not know.” Pray your anything is possible prayer and for who you have invited to worship this weekend. You ought to come to my church.

Sunday

Philippians 4:6-7

Reflect: In regard to your, with God, anything is possible prayer, what are you most anxious about?
