Serve Together Weekend | April 20 -26, 2026

Monday

1 Peter 4:10-11

Reflect: God has made you like an instrument with your own sound, tone, and role to play in his work. In that way, you have been endowed with certain spiritual gifts to be used for God's purposes. Consider how you are using your gifts. If you don't know them, consider emailing place@pathway.church to take the Place Assessment.

Prayer: Creator God, you have made me for the purpose of glorifying you. Use me and the gifts you've given me so that others might come to know you and have new life in Jesus. Reveal your will for my life to me and guide me along the way.

Tuesday

1 Corinthians 12:12

Reflect: While you are created with gifts to use for God's purposes, our faith is not meant to be practiced alone. How might you work with others who have different gifts to expand the impact in transforming your world so that it reflects God's kingdom here on earth? Who's your team? Do you need to assemble one?

Prayer: Lord, help me to remember that I am a part of a greater body called the "body of Christ." Help me and others I serve with to work better together so that we might more effectively be your hands and feet in this world.

Wednesday

Matthew 9:36

Reflect: Jesus didn't just notice people, He felt for them. He was moved by compassion. All too often, in our busy schedules, we move too fast to truly see the needs around us. But when we slow down and ask God to reveal those in need, we allow ourselves to see those who may be hurting, overlooked, or in need of kindness.

Prayer: Lord, help me to slow down the chaos in my life and in my mind. Help me to make room in my routine to notice the One More. Help me to consider how I may relate and understand them, and use me to care and serve them well for Your glory.

Thursday

James 2:26 | Galatians 5:22-23

Reflect: We are taught that faith without works is dead. It is not enough to "believe." Our actions through serving are a response to that belief, and when we live our lives driven by the Holy Spirit, our faith bears fruit. Review the fruits of the Spirit in Galatians and consider the outcome of faith in your life.

Prayer: God, you are the source of all life, energy, and goodness. Use me today as a vessel of your love. May my faith in you bring light and love today to all I might encounter.

Friday

Colossians 3:23

Reflect: If we lose sight of why we are meeting the needs around us, serving could easily become just another box to check off our regular to-do list. But if we can practice remembering how each act of service is ultimately serving our Savior, it can transform our attitude. This can create a perspective of joy that is ultimately found in purpose, rather than in completing a task.

Prayer: Lord, renew my joy in serving so that others may experience Your love through me. Help me to continually come back to the why and stress less about the how. Let me see others as You see them.

Saturday

1 Chronicles 16:8-13

Reflect: In this passage, David identifies 8 ways we can praise and glorify God. What are they and what are their benefits? Who are you inviting to worship this weekend?

Prayer: Good and magnificent God, I worship you and you only. You are my God, and I am your daughter/son. In Jesus name, amen.

Sunday

1 Chronicles 16:23-36

Reflect: Why is the daily praise of God's greatness important? How does your daily life reflect the greatness of God? Where is your growth opportunity when it comes to this idea?

Prayer: Great and glorious God, thank you for _____. In Jesus name, amen.
