Life Steps

Reasonable Doubt: About the Bible | May 25-31, 2026

Monday

2 Timothy 3:16-17

Reflect: The phrase “God breathed” can be understood as “God inspired.” How does that phrase impact your thoughts about the Bible? According to these verses, what is the purpose of the Bible, and what is your personal next step takeaway?

Prayer: Prayer: Today is Memorial Day. Jesus said, “Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.” (John 15:13) Spend some time expressing gratitude for those who willingly laid down their lives for the freedoms and way of life we enjoy.

Tuesday

Hebrews 4:12

Reflect: What does this passage reveal about the nature of God’s word? What are the benefits of reading the Bible?

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. Use it to reveal the true state of my soul and my heart.

Wednesday

Psalms 119:105

Reflect: How does this passage encourage you to rely upon reading the Bible for life direction? Memorize this verse. Recite and or write it down throughout the day.

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. Use it to reveal the path upon which you would have me travel.

Thursday

James 1:22-25

Reflect: How is the Bible like a mirror? What are some practical ways you can become a better “doer” of the word?

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. By your Holy Spirit, help me be a doer of your word and not just a hearer.

Friday

Matthew 7:24-27

Reflect: In what ways are the wise and foolish similar? Different? According to this passage, what is the foundation? What is your personal takeaway from this text?

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. Help me practice the teachings of Jesus so that the foundation of my family can withstand the storms of life.

Saturday

Matthew 4:4

Reflect: Jesus was tired, weak, weary, and hungry. Read the verse again. What is the lesson God wants you to glean from Jesus’s response to the tempter?

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. More than satisfying food for my body, I hunger for your word that nourishes my soul. Speak, Lord, speak.

Sunday

Luke 24:44-49

Reflect: Jesus speaks these words to his disciples after the resurrection, right before he ascends into heaven. How does this passage impact your understanding of the purpose of the Bible?

Prayer: God, thank you for the gift of your timeless, inspired word revealed to us in the book we call the Bible. Use it to draw me closer to Jesus and equip me to help others do the same.
