“Back to Basics”

Message: Love Jesus

Main Idea: The goal of discipleship is to love Jesus and learn to love what he loves.

Discussion

1. Stereotypically, “Marthas” always have to be doing something, while the “Marys” are more contemplative. Which is your natural tendency? Explain.
2. Martha was doing good things, but she was distracted from the main thing. When it comes to your relationship with God, what distracts you?
3. Have you ever been doing a good thing and missed the main thing? Explain
4. Like Martha, many Christians are upset and worried about many things. How does being incessantly upset and worried impact the perception of who Christians are?
5. In this story, why do you think Jesus prioritizes intimacy with him over getting tasks done in his name?
6. We were challenged to spend at least 1% of our day (10 minutes) of our day with Jesus. What do you think God would do in your soul if you gave him at the minimum that amount of time every day? (Hint: refer to the main idea above.)

Prayer: Invite everyone to share prayer requests and close your time by praying for one another.
